<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
<b>Item No. 8 July 25, 2013</b>	<p>Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that arguing counsel is not well and prays for an adjournment.</p> <p>Learned Local Commissioner has filed its inspection Report and the same is taken on record.</p> <p>From this Report, it is evident that there is still discharge of water from culvert to the village Khalilpur.</p> <p>Furthermore, there is an existing pond of waste and untreated water which will be the source of diseases and health hazards to the villagers of Khalilpur. Consequently, we direct the authorities to:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Completely block the point at culvert so that no waste and untreated water can enter the Village Khalilpur from that direction;</li><li>b) They shall remove the accumulated water with pump and carry the waste and untreated water from the pond in Khalilpur village and put it at the site which has been already earmarked for collecting such waste.</li></ol> <p>The Villagers of Khalilpur shall fully cooperate in removal of the untreated water from the pond.</p> <p>Let this be done within two weeks from today.</p> <p>List on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2013.</p>
