Date and Remarks	Order of the Tribunal
Order No. 3 6th December, 2016	<p>In terms of our directions contained in the order dated 28.11.2016 a reply has been submitted by the Respondent No. 1 today. It has been submitted that drinking water supply through tankers has been commenced to three villages namely Chhinditola, Suji and Bhorkheda by six tanks every day. However, so far as villages Bhimjori and Khurshipur are concerned that is yet to be commenced.</p> <p>We are of the view that in the light of the joint inspection report submitted in after joint inspection by the MoEF , CPCB and MPPCB with regard to the water sample analysis as mentioned on pages 6 to 9 of the said report the Respondent No. 1 needs to immediately commence water supply through tankers to the remaining villages also as the report of the joint inspection clearly suggests that the water quality in all these villages is far from satisfactory and contains several heavy metals and other pollutants which are harmful for human consumption. Learned Counsel for the Respondent No. 1 prays for some time. We direct that the supply through</p>

For reporting compliance let this matter be listed on **9th December, 2016.**

It is further directed that the Respondent No. 1 shall on commencement the water supply through tankers to all five villages as mentioned in para no. 5 of the reply submitted today namely Chhiditola, Suji, Borkheda, Bhimjori and Khurshipar shall submit the intimation to the Sub Divisional Officer who shall submit the verified reports with regard to the same before this Tribunal. Copy of this order shall be conveyed by the Respondent Nol. 1 to the SDM Baihar for submitting the compliance report before this Tribunal. It would be open for the Applicant to also verify the facts and submit their response before this Tribunal on 09.12.2016. The SDM shall also ensure that water in sufficient quantity through tankers is supplied to the villagers in proportion to their population.
