	Item No. 26 December 22, 2015	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. No. 1328 and M.A. No. 1329/2015</u></p> <p>These applications pray for extension of time to comply with the order of the Tribunal in relation to construction of R.O plants of 2.5 MLD and 6 MLD capacity at Balotra and Jasol CETPs respectively. Learned Counsel appearing for the non-applicant is present, accepts notice. We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the parties. We allow these applications and grant time to the applicant to install both the ROs by 31st January, 2016. We have made it clear that if the RO plants are not constructed and become operational by 31st January, 2016 the applicants would be liable to pay a sum of Rs. Five Lakh as cost each. These applications are allowed without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties.</p>
