Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant upon instructions from Manager of the Hotel in question and son of its proprietor, Mr. Dinesh Kapoor who is present before us submits that this Review Application be not treated as Application for review of order dated 07th December, 2017. The Applicant only prays for reduction of payment of environmental compensation imposed under the said judgment. He further states that the Applicant unconditionally accepts and submits to the judgment of the Tribunal dated 07th December, 2017 and infact would even go a step further by carrying out certain measures to improve the environment and ecology of the area, more importantly upon complying with all the directions stated in the judgment. As affirmed in paragraph 6 of this Application.</p> <p>Learned counsel further states they would be planting atleast 50 Tall trees in the area of the property in question. On this premise and undertaking of the Applicant, the counsel prays that environmental compensation imposed by the Tribunal may be reduced. As the Applicant has given an undertaking to the Tribunal which has been accepted by the Tribunal and more importantly he wishes to carry out works in the interest of environment and ecology and make the improvements in discharge of its corporate social responsibility, we reduce the environmental compensation payable by the Applicant from Rs. 10 lacs to Rs. 5 Lacs. Learned counsel submits that the said compensation could be paid within two weeks from today.</p> <p>In view of the above we dispose of the Application as the Application for variation of the Order dated 07th December, 2017.
