The entire process shall be completed within four weeks from now.</p> <p>In the meanwhile we direct the Central Pollution Control Board and State Pollution Control Board to conduct joint inspections of the areas indicated in the application, collect samples from both the rivers including the spots alleged in the application. The collection point shall be upstream and downstream and from the discharge point and also from the drain namely Buddha Nalla.</p> <p>The samples collected shall be preserved in three sets. One sample will be subjected for Chemical Analysis. Report of the samples collected shall be prepared by the joint inspection team. The report of the joint inspection shall be filed before the Tribunal within two weeks from now.</p> <p>The entire process of inspection, filing statements, objections and report shall be completed within six weeks from now.</p> <p>The inspection team shall visit the areas in question as earliest as possible and submit a report on the death of aquatic animal as indicated in the petition and whether it is related to the alleged pollution and if so, identify the source of pollution/polluters.</p> <p>List it for further proceedings on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2018.</p> <p>Issue order dasti.</p> <p>....., ACP (Dr. Jawad Rahim)</p>
