<b>Item No. 6</b> <b>6<sup>th</sup> May, 2014</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>M.A. No. 217/2014</u></b></p> <p>This miscellaneous application has been filed by the Respondent No. 1 raising objections to the maintainability of the application primarily on the ground that the complaint has already been filed for which cognizance has been taken regarding the cutting of trees without permission and as such no parallel proceedings should be allowed to run. Copy of this application has been supplied to the Applicant as well as to the learned Standing Counsel for the State/Nagarpalika, Betul.</p> <p>It is not disputed that the proceedings after having issued notices to the Respondent No. 1 have already been initiated against the Respondent No. 1 which are pending.</p> <p>Shri Manjeet Singh Sahni, the Trustee of the Gurudwara appearing on behalf of the Respondent No. 1 submitted that the Respondent No. 1 is a religious body and should not be settled with prosecution. He submitted that to mitigate what has already been the Respondent No. 1 shall deposit the amount of Rs. 21,000/- (Rs. Twenty One Thousand) on or before 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2014 with the Respondent No.2. Shri Sachin Verma, learned Standing Counsel having consulted the Officer-in-Charge submits that he will also have instruction that the Municipal Corporation shall contribute a matching grant and the aforesaid amount shall be utilised for the</p>

development of the area the Gurudwara/Respondent No. 1 which would include the cleaning the area and providing sufficient plantation of trees with regard to Respondent No. 1 undertake that they would maintain and ensure the survival of the trees so planted. It is also agreed that at lease about one hundred trees of various variety including fruit bearing trees shall be planted in the area.

Shri Sachin Verma requested to place the matter on **15<sup>th</sup> May, 2014** by which date the Respondent No. 2 shall take necessary sanctions and submit before this Tribunal, the response of the Respondent No. 2.

In the above terms, this M.A. stands disposed of.
