We permit this Unit to operate for a period of three weeks initially. The Unit shall run to its optimum capacity within one week from today. In the next coming week the joint inspection team shall visit the Unit along a senior person nominated from IIT Delhi. The Joint inspection team shall give a complete and comprehensive report whether the Unit is compliant and non-polluting or not. Further it would take samples from the inlet of ETP and outlet the ETP as well as from where the effluents is being discharged to the municipal drain.</p> <p>The analysis samples shall be tested by the UP Pollution Control Board, Central Pollution Control Board and IIT Delhi separately. The analysis reports would be submitted to the Tribunal before the next date of hearing.</p>
