Perused.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. No. 876 of 2015.</u></p> <p>Parties have no opposition to taking of the documents on record. Permission is granted to the applicant to place on record the documents mentioned in the application. M.A. No. 876 of 2015 stands disposed of accordingly.</p> <p>No reply has been filed by Respondent Nos. 8 & 9. The Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that the RTI revelations made by the NDMC are in contradiction with the stand taken by the DPCC.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the DPCC submits that he will consider the RTI revelations and would give appropriate answer at the time of hearing of main application. Let explanation to said contradiction, if any, be filed before the hearing begins. Advance copy of it be furnished to the applicant.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent No. 2 submits that on 03rd August, 2015 he</p>

had made a statement on instructions furnished by the representative of the Taj Palace who was not conversant with the Technicalities of issue and resultantly the statement was made that the hotel will take steps to switch over to the Biological STP within three months.

According to him, installation and commissioning of Biological STP is not a simple issue which can be resolved within three months as it involves substantial civil work and securing of permissions from the Local Authorities. This aspect of the issue was not contemplated by the Respondent No. 2 on the date when the statement came to be made. He further submits that the facts have been explained in order to remain free of the blame of making incorrect statement before the Tribunal.

The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Applicant seeks time to file Rejoinder and undertake to file it within one week from today. Copies of the Rejoinder may be furnished well in advance to the contending parties.
