	Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the
	respondent no. 2 submits that police protection is needed
	for carrying out the demolition at the site.
	We, therefore, direct that the respondent nos. 2
	and 3 in collaboration with each other shall carry out the
	demolition of the said identified structures within two

weeks.

We further direct the respondent no. 5-Commissoner of Police to grant every police assistance for demolition to the respondent nos. 2 and 3.

We warn the officials of respondent nos. 2, 3 and 5 that in case of any laxity shown in executing this order we will be constrained to hold concerned officer/s personally liable for such laxity and will resort to such coercive measures as are available under Order XXI and Rule 32 of the CPC Act, 1908 for compliance

Compliance Report shall be filed before the next date of hearing.
