	Item No. 04 July 29, 2016	<p>Service of affidavit dated 26-07-2016 and the annexures thereto reveal service of notice on the respondent no. 3 –Government of NCT, Department of Forest is complete.</p> <p>Respondent no. 2 has filed affidavit dated 27-07-2016 along with copies of the documents annexures 1 to 8. It is revealed from the letter dated 18-04-2016 addressed by respondent no. 2 –Government of India, Ministry of Urban Development to Deputy Conservator of Forest that demarcation of the area in question where illegal structures sought to be demolished stand has been completed and two religious structures and one platform have been identified as encroachment on the 7.5 acres of the ridge area as per the plan annexed thereto.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent no. 2 submits that police protection is needed for carrying out the demolition at the site.</p> <p>We, therefore, direct that the respondent nos. 2 and 3 in collaboration with each other shall carry out the demolition of the said identified structures within two</p>

weeks.

We further direct the respondent no. 5-
Commissioner of Police to grant every police assistance for
demolition to the respondent nos. 2 and 3.

We warn the officials of respondent nos. 2 , 3 and 5
that in case of any laxity shown in executing this order
we will be constrained to hold concerned officer/s
personally liable for such laxity and will resort to such
coercive measures as are available under Order XXI and
Rule 32 of the CPC Act, 1908 for compliance

Compliance Report shall be filed before the next
date of hearing.
