Orders of the Tribunal Date and Remarks Item No. 1 The Respondent No. 2 has filed a status report. March 5, 2014 In our earlier order dated 11.12.2013 we have directed the completion of the plantation work by the end of February, 2014. It is seen that the respondent no. 2 Forest Department has to plant 4980 saplings at Village Ghummenhera by the end of February 2014. It is now stated by the learned Counsel appearing for the respondent no. 2 that the Forest Department has already planted 1700 saplings. However, in the status report there are no particulars regarding the nature of the saplings and their survival rates. PA Particularly, the Tribunal seeks to know as to the nature of the plants, whether they are the native plants for having effective survival rate.
