



Counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 11, is a company promoted by Mohali Green Environment Private Limited and ETI Dynamics. He further points out that Respondent No. 5 - Punjab Chemicals & Crop Protection Ltd. and Respondent Nos. 9 to 12 that is Environmental Clearance by ESSIX Bio-Sciences Limited, Ally Chemical Lab. Pvt. Ltd., Nectar Life Sciences Ltd. and Saurav Chemical Factory are some of the promoters of Mohali Green Environment Private Limited and this CETP is to cater to the needs of 17 Pharmaceutical industries and few more including these Respondents referred to hereinabove in treating effluent discharged.

The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Punjab Pollution Control Board submits that there has been change in counsel of late and she has now been engaged to represent the Board. She reveals that the process of handing over of pieces and parcels of land at Khasra No. 19/21, 20/24, 20/25, 28/4, 28/5, 28/6 and 28/7, admeasuring about 7 acre, situate at Saidpura, Dera Bassi, Punjab and designated for allotment to M/s. Saidpura Enviortech Private Limited for construction of CETP in question is on and such process would be completed within a short time that is within one week or within 10 days.

There is none to categorically assert before us about the transfer of land to this company. We therefore direct the state of Punjab, Respondent No. 2 to take such steps to conclude the transaction referred to hereinabove within 10 days for expeditious commencement of the work of construction of CETP on the said land.

We are informed by the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent No. 11 – Nectar Life Sciences Ltd. one of the member companies of Mohali Green Environment Private Limited that the work of commissioning of CETP at the said land would be concluded within 8 months. We hope and trust that solemnity of statement is maintained and work of establishment of CETPs gets concluded as stated.

In order to ascertain the extent of pollution caused by each of the industry. It is necessary to understand which of the industry against whom grievance made is zero liquid discharge and, if so, what are the processes adopted for making it zero discharge. We must also understand what are the processes of each industry are and what is the nature of effluents that they are likely to generate in the course of their industrial activity. In this regard the Learned Counsel appearing for the State Pollution Control Board submitted that the presence of chemical “Atrazine, Aldrin and Pendi Methalyne” was detected in groundwater sample in the vicinity of Dhabhi Nallah. According to the State Pollution Control Board the extent of Pendi Methalyne in groundwater is within the permissible limit and all these chemicals are the components of either herbicides or weedicide or insecticides used by farmers. In this context therefore Applicant would elaborate his submissions in order to explain how these chemicals are found in the groundwater whether due to Herbicide/insecticide use by the farmer or as a result of effluent generated by any one of the industries against whom grievances are made.

The Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 15 - Punjab Small Industries and Export Corporation Limited submits that work of ETP catering to 87 industries in focal point is in the process of being constructed and commissioned. Status report in this regard would be filed before the Tribunal.
