Order No. 4 5th May, 2014	<p>Shri Shivendu Joshi, Advocate appearing for the Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board has submitted the reply copy of which has been furnished to the Applicant.</p> <p>In the reply <i>inter alia</i> it has been submitted in Para No. '5' that "the MPPCB has also issued letters to various stakeholders/duty holders like industries etc. for implementation of the provisions of the Rules.....". It is further submitted that for the implementation of the Rules, the industry has not come forward and remains in infringement of the Rules so far as collection and disposal of waste is concerned, primarily all the products manufactured by them. On being asked, learned counsel for the Pollution Control Board submitted that he would file a list of such stakeholders and duty holders as well as the members of the industry who are responsible for the same with a prayer for their being impleaded as party.</p>

As far as the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel is concerned, he is free to move such application and as and when such application is filed, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law.

Shri Shivendu Joshi & Shri Sandeep Singh, learned counsel seek time to file reply.
