	Item No. 16 August 24, 2016 PS	<p>Grievance is regarding discharge of untreated waste water in the pond situated behind the factory of Respondent No. 4 M/s Hindustan Coca Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd. .</p> <p>Local investigation by the team of Officials involved in Joint Inspection and the Additional Director of CPCB was ordered in view of the allegations made that there were some breaches in the perimeter wall of the Respondent No. 4 Hindustan Coca Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd. vide order dated 26th April, 2016. Now we have before us the result of the local investigation as per the report dated 5th July, 2016.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the UPPCB submits that some recommendations have been made in Joint Inspection Report and its compliance by the industry is expected. We hope that such compliance is made and the facts revealed before us on the next date of hearing.</p>

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Applicant submits that he has yet to respond to the Joint Inspection Report and sometime be granted particularly for the reason of medical contingency regarding the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Applicant.

Now, it is submitted on behalf of the Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 4 M/s Hindustan Coca Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd. that they will be filing an affidavit to bring before this Tribunal the resolution of the entire controversy by entering into an agreement with the Irrigation Department Bulandsheher to bodily lift the untreated effluent and transfer to Hasanpur Nala for its ultimate disposal.

Let this affidavit be filed.

Advance copy of the Affidavit to be filed by the Respondent No. 4 M/s Hindustan Coca Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd. shall be furnished to other parties in the present proceedings or their counsels.
