1	It is alleged in this application that the East Coast Railway Division

11.	on 6 th April 2010 by the Odisha State Pollution Control Board	
	identifying that the category of transportation, storage, loading and	
2	unloading of mineral at stack yard/railway siding are of red category as	
	they have high pollution potential.	
	From the pleadings it appears that the Odisha State Pollution	
	Control Board took an action by issuing show cause. Thereafter the	
	closure notice was also issued which is annexed with the application.	
	But thereafter surprisingly that closure notice was revoked without	
	any compliance by the East Coast Railway in terms of obtaining	
	consent to operate from the Board. At the present moment, the	
	railway siding is in operation without consent from the Board.	
	Having regard to the guidelines for seeking consent to operate	
	in terms of the Board's resolution No. 3369 dated 16.02.2008, we are	

of the view that prima face a case has been made out for adjudication. The application is thus admitted for hearing. Let notice be served upon the respondents by dasti/speed post/registered post along with the copy of the application and today's order on usual terms.

The Odisha State Pollution Control Board is directed to file the status report in the form of affidavit explaining the reason why the closure notice was withdrawn on the next date fixed. The other respondents are directed to file the reply, if any, within four weeks. Rejoinder, if any, to the reply within two weeks thereafter. Matter is posted to 17.07.2015 for consideration of the status report of the State Board and the respective respondents. In the meantime, the Odisha Pollution Control Board is directed to take all steps and measures in accordance with law as admissible with reference to the allegation as made in this application.

For proper adjudication of the matter leave is granted to the applicant to add the General Manager, East Coast Railway, Bhubaneswar as party respondent in this proceeding.

Matter is posted to 17.07.2015.
