	But, we are informed today that no inspection in
	light of the aforesaid directions have been made. It is
	submitted by the Counsel for State Pollution Board that
	earlier they had taken details on the subject from time,
	to time, when consent was obtained.
	It is rather strange that the Respondent No.2
	State Pollution Board do not care for the directions
	given to them and are trying to give explain for not
	conducting inspection on the ground which is not
	relevant for the purpose for which we had directed the
	inspection on last date. In case, whatever details and

response is being given to us today was sufficient for the purpose for which the directions were issued then on the last date of hearing then explanation about the same should have been given at the time when the order was passed.

We deem it proper to direct that an inspection be conducted by the State Pollution Board in respect of two grounds ,namely:

- a. Insect the individual unit connected with CETP ,particularly in respect of parameter and quantum of effluent.
- b. Inspect the individual unit and identify those which are discharging 100 kld and whether those units are having their ETP with workable RO and RO Management System.

The report of the said inspection be furnished, with the copy to the other side, on or before 23.05.2016.

Let the matter be listed before Circuit Bench at Jodhpur on 30th May, 2016.
