- b) What is the extent of performance of their respective statutory functions with reference to the ground realities at the site. The committee shall visit the affected areas personally.
- c) The short term and long term action plan to ensure prevention and control of pollution particularly ambient air quality in that area.
- d) The samples of ambient air quality and noise pollution shall be taken and analysis Report be placed before the Tribunal. Furthermore, it shall also observe with regard to traffic congestion in that area.
