	Broadly speaking many things are required to be done to achieve the
	compliance of our directions in complete measures. We have noticed
	therefrom that the site is presently used for dumping of the mixed waste by
	the Latur Municipal Corporation and the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board
	had granted authorisation for using it for MSW Processing Plant in February
	2014 and was to remain valid till 31 st March 2015. It appears that a renewal
	proposal is submitted to the MPCB and the same is pending for fresh renewal
	of the authorisation.
	Learned counsel appearing on behalf of MPCB placed before us a

copy of the Visit Report dated 31st December 2016. Observations made by Mr. P.B. Bavane, Field Officer, Sub Regional Officer, Latur are found recorded in the visit report. It reveals that the Officer made visit to the site and found the mechanical processing plant in operation. However, this statement is qualified with a fact that the operation of the mechanical processing plant is intermittent due to mechanical failure and the plant partially handles the MSW to the extent of 50 to 60 M. Tonnes out of 150 M.Tonnes per day of the MSW. This signifies that the balance of 100 M. Tonnes per day of MSW is left dumped at the site without any further process. This will only compound problem further. All concerned, therefore are required to take concrete measures for setting the things right in tune with the latest MSW Rules 2016. We, therefore, pass the following directions:

Let the Secretary, Urban Development, Govt. of I) Maharashtra hold meeting of the stake holders namely No.1, the Commissioner, Respondent Municipal Corporation Latur, Respondent No.2 Collector, District Respondent No.3 Member Secretary, Latur and Maharashtra Pollution Control Board within a week, discuss all the issues necessary for implementation of the MSW Rules, 2016, draw an action plan for its implementation suggesting short term and long term measures to be taken within given time frame and place such action plan including the provisions made for financing its execution before us on the next date.

All the concerned parties shall take note of this order. Registry shall communicate the order to Secretary, Urban Development, Government of Maharashtra, Member Secretary, Maharashtra State Pollution Control Board and the Collector, District Latur.

M.A.No.275/2016 stands disposed of.
