Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
Item No. 04 & 05 November 04, 2016 A	<p>We have heard the Learned counsel appearing for the parties. The joint inspection report of the committee has been placed on record. Response to the joint inspection report has also been filed. Having considered the record before us, we dispose of these Applications with the following directions:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. That the controversy involved in the present application has already been decided by the Tribunal vide Order dated 27th October, 2016 in Original Application Nos. 510/2016 and 511/2016. The same directions, besides ones specifically stated in this order, shall apply <i>Mutatis Mutandis</i> to the present case.2. The Unit will not be permitted to operate without specific orders of the Tribunal. After the Unit has complied with all the recommendations made by the joint inspection team, it will inform the Board. The

Joint Inspection Team shall again conduct an inspection and if the Unit is found to be non-polluting and compliant in all respects. Then its application for grant of consent may be dealt with, in accordance with law.

3. If the consent to operate is granted the same will not become operative without specific Orders of the Tribunal.

4. The Unit shall disclose to the joint inspection team the source of their raw-material. What was the source in the past and what is the proposed source, in relation to the quantum and utilization both.

5. The inspection would be carried out at the cost of the Unit.

With the above directions, Original Application Nos. 540/2016 and Original Application No. 541/2016 stand disposed of, without any order as to costs.
