Item No. 3	Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 7 Municipal

2013	newspapers as also calling e-tender with regard to the establishment of			
V	these STPs at Mandideep District Raisen. It is submitted that the			
	technical bids have been examined. Financial bids are being opened

-	The Applicant drew out attention to the directions issued in our			
	order of 07.05.2015, particularly with reference to the green belt to act as			
	breakers keeping in view the sensitiveness of the area which is in close			
	proximity with Bhimbetka, a world heritage site. Learned Counsel Shri			
	Sachin K. Verma submits that he may be allowed some time to submit as			
	to what steps the administration as well as the local authority, MPF			
	and MPAKVN wishes to take or have taken in this behalf.			
	It has also been brought to our notice that the MPAKVN is also			
	proposing to come up with an extension of Phase-II of the Industrial Area			
	in Mandideep. We expect that the MPAKVN while drafting the			
	proposals and planning the same must have already taken into account the			
	environmental issue with particular reference to the area in question. Shri			

Sachin K.Verma submits that he will take instructions in this behalf and make his submissions before the Tribunal on the next date.

The State as well as the MPAKVN and Respondent No. 7 / Town Municipality shall also submit as to what would be the increase in the population as a result of the coming up of Phase-II of the MPAKVN at Mandideep and also what areas are likely to be developed as residential area. At present the residential area are upstream of the Industrial Area and as such the tapping of the nallah allowing to flow into the river and STP of municipal authorities is to take care of the existing inflow of sewage. We would also like the Respondents to verify whether it would be feasible for developing the residential areas on the upstream so that any inflow of sewage can also be taken care of by the STP that is being planned.

Learned Counsel appearing for the MPPCB shall also apprise the Tribunal in the form of affidavit as to whether developing of Phase-II of the Industrial park at Mandideep would require Environmental Clearance to be obtained by the promoter i.e. MPAKVN or by the individual units that may be set up. We would also like to know from the Respondents as to whether there is any plan for identifying the nature of industries i.e. likely to be installed and established in the Phase-II and whether issues like the high level of pollution in the river Betwa as also Ambient Air Quality have been taken care of while planning the Phase-II.
