<b>Item No. 4</b> <b>6th July, 2015.</b>	<p>Heard Mr. Ritwick Dutta, Id. Advocate appearing for the applicants in full. His arguments are concluded.</p> <p>During course of argument, a prayer has been made for grant of an injunction on the ground that one of the villages viz. Chadong is on the verge of submersion and paddy field, banana plantation etc. are already submerged. In support of his contention, newspaper report (Times of India, Pune dt. 28<sup>th</sup> June 2015) has been produced. At page 7 it is reported that due to Mapithel dam project at Manipur vast areas have been sub-merged and there were agitation by affected people. Some photographs have also been produced. Considering the position,</p>

we grant liberty to file appropriate application seeking injunction after serving copy to the other sides. The documents and photographs produced be kept with the record.

Mr. S.B.Meiti, Id. Adv. for respondents 1 and 3 seeks liberty to file rejoinder to the reply filed by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. He is at liberty to do so after serving copy to the applicant before the next date fixed. He also seeks liberty to file certain documents. He may do so by way of a supplementary affidavit with copy to the applicant before the next date.

All parties agreeing, the matter is **fixed on 14.7.2015 as part heard**. It is made clear that the date is peremptory and no adjournment will be granted on any ground.
