Remarks		
Order No. 5	We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the	
September 17, 2013	Applicant and the Respondents. The Respondent No. 8 (Senior	
2013	Superintendent of Police) had filed reply affidavit which has been	
	taken on file. The Learned Counsel for Respondent No. 6 (New	
	Okhla Industrial Development Authority) has filed preliminary report	
	about 55 projects which are stated in the application. According to	
	the Learned Counsel, out of 55 the serial No. 10, 12, 13, 14, 39 and	
	42 are out of the area and therefore those project need not be taken	
	into consideration. In so far, as it relates to the remaining 49	
	projects, according to the Learned Counsel, admittedly that they are	
	within 10km from the bird sanctuary. But the Learned Counsel	
	submitted that they have obtained the necessary clearance and	
	therefore there is no restriction on their part from proceeding with	
	the construction. Learned Counsel further submits that out of these	
	49 projects, 7 projects have not been started and 15 Projects have	
	been completed. Let the Respondent No. 6 file a detailed report	
	about the fact.	
	When it is brought by us to the notice of the Learned Counsel	

that there is an order dated 14th August, 2013 preventing any further construction which is against them, the Learned Counsel would fairly submit that the Respondent No. 6 would take all steps to see that no further constructions are made in respect of the said 49 Project. The Learned Counsel also undertakes to file all particulars and details relating to the 49 Projects including the source from where they draw water for their project, by the next date of hearing.

We make it very clear that the earlier order restraining the construction without proper authority shall be implemented scrupulously and the Respondent No. 7(District Magistrate) and Respondent No. 8 (Senior Superintendent of Police) are directed to see that restriction is implemented and no further construction are done in respect of 49 units and report the same by the next date of hearing.

Learned Counsel for Respondent No. 1 (MoEF) as well as the Respondent No. 5 (National Board of Wild Life) seeks time to file reply. The said Respondent shall file the reply by the next date of hearing failing to which coercive steps will be taken against the said respondents. It is made clear that MoEF in its reply shall clearly state the areas which are within 10 km from the Okhla Bird Sanctuary including NCR areas.

Respondent No. 4(Uttar Pradesh Irrigation Department) also undertakes to file its reply by the next date of hearing.
