	Item No. 13 May 20, 2016 jg	<p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Rajasthan upon instructions submits that they would carry out the directions /recommendations already issued by the Tribunal vide its order dated 4th August, 2015. However, he submits that the road and the ring road as directed already exist and therefore, there is no occasion for construction of new roads. He further states that instead of constituting a Board, as the area falling in the share of Rajasthan is only 1.2 km and there is no big temple located in that area, they will constitute a small committee which will have the SDM as the Chairman, Two Public Representatives who are actively involved in the maintenance and looking after of the Parikarma and One Revenue Officer and One Officer from the Forest Department.</p> <p>We further direct that they would now first carry out the plantation around the Parikarma and plant not less than thousand trees in the area of 1.2 km falling in the jurisdiction of State of Rajasthan.</p>

With the above directions the Original Application No. 24/2016 stands disposed of with no order as to costs.
