Mr. Pradeep Mishra, Adv. submits that the hazardous waste can be beneficially utilized for filling requirement of overbridges on the <i>Kachha Area</i>. The feasibility can be ascertained from National Highways Authority of India and Central Pollution Control Board.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for Central Pollution Control Board submits that they have not received any proposal, if such proposal is received, they will examine and place it before the Tribunal.
