Advocate for the Respondent No. 4, Royal Calcutta Turf Club, submits that the respondent No. 4 has taken a large number of measures for taking care of the discharge of waste water and for dealing with solid waste. He further submits that they are in the process of preparing a detailed project for it. He prays that time be granted to place such report before the Tribunal.
