Item No. 5 August 7, 2015	<p>The present application concerns the groundwater pollution in the Districts of Saharanpur, Muzaffarnagar, Samli, Meerut, Bagpath and Ghaziabad caused as a result of effluents being released under ground by reverse boring by the industries within these districts.</p> <p>The Respondents seek time to file replies. It is submitted on behalf of the UPPCB that a similar grievance particularly regarding the availability of the potable water to the villagers situated within these districts has been suitably redressed vide order dated 5.8.2015 passed in the Original Application No. 231/2014. According to him, there is no much urgency in the matter. Two weeks time is granted for filing replies. Advance copies of the replies be furnished to the applicant who may file rejoinder thereto, if any, within a week thereafter.</p> <p>In the meanwhile, considering the nature of allegations made, we expect the UPPCB to place before us the list of industries generating effluents in</p>

the said districts. UPPCB shall also place before us the chemical composition of the effluents generated by each industry.
