Item No.2 May 8, 2014 Order No.7	<p>We have heard Applicant in person. We have also heard the Counsel for Saswad Municipal Council and perused the affidavit of Shri. Vyankatesh Durdas, Chief Officer of Municipal Council. The affidavit shows that solid waste treatment plant at Kumbharvalan is established and roads would be completed for the purpose of transportation of garbage/MSW from near the school premises and other places, where it has been stacked. It is further stated that the Respondent No.1, (Municipal Council) intends to complete the work of MSW plant, including construction of inner roads and approach roads by the end of June, 2014. The Counsel for Respondent No.2, makes a statement that entire solid waste/garbage, would be shifted to Kubharvalan, prior to 1st July, 2014 and sincere efforts will be taken to make composting plant functional. He points out that due to relaxation of the Code of Conduct to certain extent, the tendering process has been started. Tomorrow tenders are likely to be published and the tendering work will be immediately processed and approved. According to the Counsel for Municipal Council, the MSW plant at Kumbharvalan has received Authorisation from the competent authority and there will be no difficulty in making the plant operational before first week of July, 2014, in all respects.</p> <p>We direct that the Municipal Council under the supervision of MPCB officers shall execute the work at the earliest and in any case, shall complete the work of MSW plant before 1st week of July, 2014 and also complete shifting of garbage/MSW from the city area to the said plant at Kumbharvalan, without putting up any excuse.</p> <p>We further direct the Respondent No.1, Municipal Council to set out an action plan for segregation of biomedical waste, biodegradation</p>

waste and plastic waste, and should make such plan available for perusal of the Tribunal. So also, the scheme for implementation of biomedical waste in the city, shall be placed on record before scheduled date of hearing.

The Applicant states that the amount collected by the Municipal Council towards payment of taxes as 'Health Tax' should be utilized for the benefit of students of the school and citizens for protection of health, by implementing schemes. We keep such issue open and desire to deal with it after the above beneficial schemes are implemented.
