This only means that the applicant, who moved this application before the Rajasthan High Court and now eventually is before us due to its transfer has to suffer the menace of water logging atleast for three more years and perhaps, for some more indefinite period, if the wrangling continues to occur. We further direct the Sujangarh Municipal Council to place DPR of the work under taken before us to find way to resolve the problem.</p> |
