<p>Item No.5 10th October, 2013</p>	<p>This application is filed under Section 18 of the National Green Tribunal Act. During the course of hearing it was revealed that initially the land in dispute (Khasra No. 85 and its new No. 114 in village Kamta District Panna) was classified as 'Talaiya'. It appears that subsequently the classification came to be altered and even the area of the 'Talaiya' was reduced.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel for the applicant contended the fact that against the alteration of the classification of the land under Section 144 of MP Land Revenue Code 1959, an appeal was filed before the Divisional Commissioner.</p> <p>Based on the above, the Learned Counsel for the applicant sought permission to withdraw this application with liberty to approach before the Commissioner for challenging the orders by which the classification of the land was altered from 'Talaiya' to 'Banjar'.</p> <p>The prayer of the Learned Counsel for the applicant is allowed. Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file the appeal in accordance with law.
