2	for appraisal of the projects for construction in Mumbai Metropolitan
-	Region, Maharashtra and was referred in the Notification as SEAC-II.
	We have not come across any Notification whereby the same
	Committee was authorized to conduct appraisal of other activities in
	Nagpur/Bhandara districts, including environment impact, particularly,
	in respect of the sand extraction from the river bed/basin etc. The
	learned Advocate (Sh.Mahabal) has placed on record another
	Notification dated 30th January, 2014, which shows that another
	Committee is newly constituted under the chairmanship of Sh. T.C.
	Benjamin and is called SEAC-I, for appraisal of all the projects relevant
	to Industries, Mining, Irrigation and others, excluding building projects in
	the State of Maharashtra. Thus, it appears that Sh. T.C. Benjamin

February 19, 2014 Order No.10 projects in the State of Maharashtra though no such Committee was in existence, when the e-auction was conducted.

Mr. D.M.Gupte, learned Advocate, appearing for the Respondent Nos.3 and 4, would submit that in a short while i.e. tomorrow a Meeting is scheduled to resolve the issue at the level of SEAC-I, under the chairmanship of Sh. T.C. Benjamin. Hence, he seeks adjournment to clarify the position after obtaining further instructions.

Considering the complexity involved in relation to the legality of the acts of the Committees and the Authorities, as regards appraisal that was required to be done, we deem it proper to allow the learned Advocate for the Respondent Nos.3 and 4, to give response by way of additional affidavit, as may be available under instructions of the competent officer of Sh. T.C. Benjamin Committee. Such additional affidavit may be filed on or before 4th March, 2014 and the copies thereof be furnished to other side. Ad-interim order to continue till then.
