We direct that this order should be complied with positively before the next date of hearing and the Environmental Scientists/Engineers working in Bio Medical Section of the DPCC should not be burdened with other duty and this order should be complied without any further delay.

This matter would come up for hearing on 31st October, 2013 and shall also be listed on 1st October, 2013 in terms of our previous order.
