Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Madhya Pradesh (Respondent No. 2) submitted that with a view to resolve the impasse the State would be willing to call a meeting of the affected parties including representative of the affected persons whose land or properties is likely to be submerged as a result of construction of the dam by the Respondent No. 3. Such a meeting would include the Applicant or his representative, the affected persons or organization through his or its representative as well as Respondent No. 3 (Project Proponent) and Respondent No. 4 (M.P. Power Generating Co. Ltd.).

Orders of the Tribunal

It is submitted that all the affected parties or their representative would submit their proposals and exchange the same prior to convening of such meeting and the parties consider the proposal submitted by each of the parties and come with their proposals for finding a solution to the impasse which has been created as the parties agree that the present *status quo* is not serving the interest of any of the parties.

The Learned Counsel for the parties submitted that they would exchange their proposals within a period of 6 weeks and during 2 weeks thereafter the Respondent No. 2-State would convene the meeting for all the parties and also invite the Respondent No.1 or their representative in such a meeting.

The matter may be listed on 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2014.

In case, however, the proposals are not exchanged within 6 weeks, the parties would inform this Tribunal by filing a miscellaneous application to pre-pone the date of hearing.
