	Item No. 4 July 3, 2015 DV	<p>Learned Counsel appearing for the respondents on instructions from the CEO of Kurukshetra Development Board submits that they had consulted Forest Research Institute Dehradun regarding the steps necessary to be taken in the matter of de-concretization of trees at Jyotisar-part of Kurukshetra and upon such consultation have actually de-concretized the ancient holy Banyan trees removed all the electricity wires, any kind of boards, signage, nails and screws and such other superficial attachment there from and others and have almost satisfied the prayers made at clause A and B. He further submits that as regards the satisfaction of the prayer clause-C, the respondents are seriously contemplating an action and would revert back with the statement as to what requires to be done as regards the trees spread out in the entire area of Kurukshetra.</p> <p>He also submits that an appropriate reply disclosing the facts would be placed on record and therefore sometime be granted to the respondents to do so. One week time is granted for filing such response.</p>
