The diesel trucks which are 10 years old and are being used by the Delhi Cantonment Board shall not be used or ply for any purpose whatsoever in the entire NCT, Delhi. 2. These trucks shall be auctioned for the purpose of dismantling and/or being plied in the area outside of Delhi which have been identified as the area where the ambient air quality is within the prescribed standards. 3. The registration would be effected only after submission of proof to the above effect before the registering authority with CD thereof. 4. The new trucks that will be registered which are BS-IV compliant shall be used by the Delhi Cantonment Board only for transportation of waste and will not be used for any private purpose. 5. All the vehicles will be fixed GPS and it will be ensured that the waste is transported to the identified sites as already ordered by the Tribunal in the connected matters. <p>With the above directions M.A. No. 147 of 2017 stands disposed of.
