	In the meanwhile, the State of Kerala shall not register any diesel
	vehicle with the capacity of 2000 CC and above, except Public
	Transport and Local Authority Vehicle. Further, we direct that all the
	diesel vehicles, whether light or heavy, which are more than ten
	years old, shall not be permitted to ply on the road in the major
	Cities like Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Kochi, Thrissur, Calicut and

Kannur. Upon expiry of 30 days from today, if any vehicle is found to be violating this direction, then it would be liable to pay Rs.5,000/-per violation, as Environmental Compensation. This would be collected by the Traffic Police and/or the Pollution Control Board. The State Pollution Control Board shall maintain a separate account in this behalf. The fund so collected shall be spent only for betterment of environment in these cities, subject to orders of the Tribunal.

In this regard, we may also refer to the orders passed by the Larger Bench of the Principal Bench in the case of VARDHMAN KAUSHIK Vs. UNION OF INDIA and the order of the Supreme Court in the case of M.C. MEHTA Vs. UNION OF INDIA.

The State Government shall inform the Tribunal as to the availability of CNG gas for running of vehicles in the entire State.
