Perused Record.</p> <p>Affidavit dated 9<sup>th</sup> February 2017 sworn by Mr. Suryakant Doke, Regional Officer, MPCB, Pune, who visited the site and collected samples for water analysis from dug well and tube well located in the vicinity of Respondent No.1 M/s Aurangabad Distillery Pvt Ltd, reveals that water samples taken from the dug well of the Applicant had pale brownish colour. The analysis result at Annexure-III to the affidavit reveals the detection of Turbidity, Sulphates, Chlorides, Nitrate-N, BOD, COD in the given quantity as mentioned in the said Report.
