	Corporation, as per the order dated May 12th, 2014. We direct him to
	place on record such order. He, however, was unable to produce on
	record the relevant copy of the order. In the interest of justice, we

	along with affidavit of the Chief Officer/competent officer, who has
	issued such order and steps taken to ensure that diversion of
	'Khemani' Nulla is, in fact, done in order to avoid discharge of
