	Item No. 09 April 15, 2015	<p>Keeping in view of the urgency of the matter that dredging needs to be carried out in the interest of public and adherence to the water requirements and flow of the river, we direct that the Contractor shall pay Rs. 500 per cubic meter for the material given to him under the contract. This amount, of course, would be subject to adjustments and without prejudice to the rights of the contractor and may be used for environmental restoration purpose in future. As it is agreeable to all the Learned counsel appearing in the case, without prejudice to their respective rights and contention, we permit the Department to carry on the dredging in terms of the contract but subject to the above conditions. The weight/volume of the material that is removed from the site by the contractor in terms of the payment shall be measured in the presence of the officer nominated by the Revenue Department in addition to the contractor and DJB. The random samples of transported material shall also be taken and analysed by the DPCC.</p>
