In this application also similar questions have been raised as it also is concerned about the environment and ecology of the Sardar Samand Lake. It is also brought to our notice that similar question was raised in the case of <i>Abdul Rahman V/s State of Rajasthan in Writ Petition 1536/2003</i> decided on 02.07.2004 by the Divisional Bench of Rajasthan High Court wherein certain directions had been issued based upon the State Level Expert Committee by the State in September 2003 details of which are there in Para No. 15 of the Judgement.</p> <p>Issue notice to M.A. No 681/2015 also praying for interim stay.
