Item No. 9 August 11, 2014	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>Mr. Tarun Johri, Tree Officer/Deputy Conservator of Forest, South submits that the counting of trees in the area in question i.e. Uday Shankar Park was carried out in the presence of the Applicant members and counting of the trees revealed that there are 197 trees presently standing and 10 trees have been felled. He submits that the trees felled were the trees affected by construction in question and felling was done pursuant to the orders duly granted therefor.</p> <p>He further submits that none of the trees felled belongs to the species of trees, namely, Ficus, Bargad, Peepal, Gular and Pilkhan which can survive transplanting /translocation in harsh climate location in Delhi; and as such translocation of the said trees was ruled-out as unviable position.</p> <p>He submits a report dated 10.08.2014. That report is taken on record. Copy of the report is furnished to the Applicant.
