I, K.Nalini, D/o. K.Krishnasamy, aged about, 59 years, having my office at 76, Mount Salai, Guindy, Chennai-600032, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely state as follows:-

- 1. I submit that I am working as the Joint Chief Environmental Engineer, Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred as TNPCB), Chennai 600 032, and I am authorized to file this Report on behalf of the Second Respondent of the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case from the available office records.
- 2. It is respectfully submitted that on 30.4.2024, the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, (PB) registered the O.A. No.477 of 2024 (PB) as a Suo Motu based on the News item appeared in "The Times of India" dated 19.02.2024 titled "Buckingham Canal remains choked with garbage sewage."
- 3. It is respectfully submitted that the Hon'ble NGT, (PB) directed the TNPCB to file its inspection report conducted on 27.4.2024 along with the ROA of the samples and the comprehensive report showing the status of the Buckingham Canal. The Hon'ble NGT, (PB) directed to transfer the said OA to Hon'ble NGT, (SZ), Chennai for further appropriate action.

- 4. It is respectfully submitted that the O.A No.477 of 2024, (PB) was renumbered as O.A No. 194 of 2024 by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, (SZ) on 1.8.2024 and directed the respondents to file their reports.
- 5. It is respectfully submitted that as per the directions of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunals the Second Respondents submits its report herein.
- 6. It is respectfully submitted that the Buckingham Canal stretch of 500 M from either side of MRTS railway station, Chepauk was inspected on 29.04.2024 and report was submitted before Hon'ble NGT (PB) as follows:
 - a. The less numbers of Plastic pet bottles and garbage were floated in the said canal.
 - b. It is also reported by the surrounding public that, the greater Chennai Corporation has cleaned the said stretch of Buckingham Canal on 26.04.2024.
 - c. There is no water clogging in the canal and free flow of water was found.
 - d. Samples were collected during the inspection on 29.04.2024.
- 7. It is respectfully submitted that the report of ROA for the samples collected during the inspection on 29.04.2024 reveals that, except pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Total Nitrogen, all other parameters exceed the drinking water standards prescribed by the Board. The ROA of the samples is enclosed as Annexure I.

- 8. It is respectfully submitted that the Buckingham Canal stretch of 500 M from either side of MRTS railway station, Chepauk was again inspected on 23.07.2024 and the action taken by the O/o. DEE, Chennai, (South), TNPCB are as follows:
 - a. The few numbers of Plastic pet bottles and garbage were stagnated in one side of the said canal. In this regard, the local body (GREATER CHENNAI CORPORATION ZONE IX) is instructed to remove the said garbage's from the canal. Also, a letter was addressed to Greater Chennai Corporation-Zone IX on 25.07.2024(Enclosed as Annexure - II) to provide net mesh in the places, wherever it requires/the sewage outfalls entering into the said canal to avoid clogging/choking of canal by the plastic garbage's and to ensure the free flow of water periodically.
 - b. It is also reported by the surrounding public that, the Greater Chennai Corporation has cleaned the said stretch of Buckingham Canal periodically by the Corporation.
 - c. There is no water clogging in the canal and free flow of water was found except in one place.
- 9. It is respectfully submitted that the Buckingham Canal stretch of 500 M from either side of MRTS railway station, Chepauk was again inspected on 27.08.2024 and the samples were collected on the same day that reveals that except pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Total Nitrogen, all other parameters exceed the drinking water standards prescribed by the Board. The ROA of the samples are enclosed as Annexure III.

 - c. It was informed by the publics that the greater Chennai Corporation has cleaned the said stretch of Buckingham Canal on 07.10.2024 and its cleaned twice in a month by the Corporation.
 - d. Photographs taken during the inspection are enclosed as Annexure IV.

Therefore, it is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (Southern Zone) may be pleased to pass such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case and thus render justice.
