	<b>Item No. 09 October 31, 2018 R</b>	<p>Proceedings have been initiated in this matter on receipt of a letter alleging that there is high pollution in peripheral areas of Udhna Udyog Nagar and other nearby residential area at Surat, Gujarat by Chinko Silk Mills.</p> <p>The mill is using petroleum coal, releasing black fog, adversely affecting the passengers and workers of the railway, as the mill is near the railway station.
