Application is registered based on a complaint received by E-mail.

ORDER

1. Grievance of the applicant Mr. Saleem is regarding water and air pollution caused by one 'Om Heat Treatment Centre', Gali No.3, Opp. Shyam Dharam Kanta, Hindon Vihar, Meerut Road, Ghaziabad, UP which is running in a residential area. It is submitted that the plant keeps releasing the fumes continuously causing health problems to the residents of nearby area. It is further submitted that this plant has not even installed STP (Sewerage Treatment Plant) and ETP (Effluent Treatment Plant) with the result that waste water is directly being discharged into canals and is thereby causing water pollution. The applicant has also annexed a copy of RTI application filed by Mr. Subhas Chandra, Advocate before the PRO, Nagar Nigam, Ghaziabad.

2. Having regard to the seriousness of the allegations, we form a Joint Committee of State PCB and District Magistrate, Ghaziabad, U.P. to look into the grievance. The State PCB will be the Nodal agency for coordination and compliance. The Joint Committee may meet within four weeks and undertake site visit and look into the grievance of the applicant. Factual and action taken report may be furnished within three months before the Ld. Registrar General, National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench at New Delhi by e-mail at judicial-ngt@gov.in preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF and, if necessary, the Ld. Registrar General may put the matter before the Bench for necessary directions.

The application stands disposed of.
