**ORDER**

1. In pursuance of order dated 13.09.2018, a report has been furnished by the Central Pollution Control Board and Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board (RSPCB) on the issue of alleged water pollution from discharge of effluents by Insecticides India Limited. The recommendations and the conclusion in the report are as follows:

**“2.2 Recommendations**

1. The industry needs to submit reply to the queries raised by the RSPCB and get the consent to operate (CTO) under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 renewed from RSPCB at the earliest.
2. The industry needs to install disinfection system (Chlorination) after the activated carbon filtration unit to reduce the microbial contamination in treated effluent.
3. The industry needs to install night vision PTZ camera for covering, ETP outlet, solid and liquid hazardous waste feeding point. Alkaline scrubber, and filter press and provide connectivity to RSPCB server.
4. The RSPCB needs to keep a continuous vigil on the operation of the ETP including maintaining ZLD.

### 2.3 Conclusion

- *The industry has provided the ETP for treatment of liquid waste generating from the industry and found in operation and not discharging any effluent outside the premises from the ETP. The quality of the treated effluent is within the prescribed limit.*
- *The industry has provided multi-cyclone followed by alkali scrubber for HW incinerator and multi-cyclone and bag filters for steam generating boiler for controlling of air pollution which are adequate.*
- *As per the HW authorization, the industry is sending the incinerator ash to TSDF Udaipur and maintaining the HW manifest.”*

2. In view of above, no further direction is required except that the industry must comply with the recommendations to the satisfaction of the RSPCB. The compliance report may accordingly be secured by the RSPCB.

3. A copy of the report of the joint inspection may be furnished to the applicant by e-mail.

The application is disposed of.
