We have heard Mr. Sanjay Parikh, learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General appearing for the Union of India, Narmada Control Authority and the State of Gujarat and the learned counsel appearing for the State of M.P.

On 18-9-2019, we passed the following order which is extracted below:-

"Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners confines his prayer on the point that if the High Level Committee/Review Committee meets and takes a decision about the maintenance of the water level and for rehabilitation of the project affected families, this would suffice for him."

Learned Solicitor General appearing for the respondents has agreed that they will conduct the Review Committee meetings as per Clause XIV, Sub-clause 14 of the Narmada Water Disputes Tribunal Award. The Committee will meet and take a decision about the water level as well as rehabilitation issues involved in the matter.

In view of the above, we direct the Review Committee to hold meeting(s) expeditiously and take a decision in the matter.

With the above observations, the Writ Petition is disposed of.

As prayed, learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners is permitted to send a representation to the Review Committee about the rehabilitation issues involved in the matter.

Pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
