**ORDER**

I.A. No. 127/2019 has been filed on behalf of Pali  
Water Pollution Control Treatment & Research Foundation  
(respondent no. 5) with the prayer for relaxation of time  
frame for depositing the amount, as ordered on 31.01.2019.

By the said order an environment compensation of Rs. One

crore was to be deposited with CPCB, within one month. The instant application had been filed on 25.02.2019.

It has been submitted by the counsel for applicant that an amount of Rs. 50 lakhs has already been deposited. It is further submitted that for deposit of the remaining amount further time be granted and the same be allowed to be deposited in installments.

Having heard the learned counsel for the applicant and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances under which the order of 31.01.2019 was passed by us, we deem it proper to grant last opportunity to Pali Water Pollution Control Treatment & Research Foundation to deposit the entire remaining amount, on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2019. It is made clear that no further shall be granted and appropriate coercive order would be passed in case of failure to deposit the amount, within the extended period.

Consequently, I.A. No. 127/2019 stand disposed of, with no order as to cost.

**I.A. No. 128/2019**

Heard the learned counsel for the applicant. Issue notice to the State Government and MoEF. The counsels for the said respondents present in court, accept notice and waive service. The learned counsel for the applicant shall supply a copy of the application to the respective counsels, during the course of the day. The said respondents may

file their response to the application, if any, before the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the counsel for the applicant.

**Main matter**

Earlier order was passed on 31.01.2019 and directions were issued to different departments of the State to be complied within time frame.

So far as only Secretary, Department of Environment, Central Ground Water Board and State Pollution Control Board have filed their compliances.

Therefore, we direct the Secretary, Agriculture; Secretary, Department of Health; State Transport Department, State Water Resources; Commissioner, Pali Nagar Nigam; Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur and Collector, Pali granted to file their compliances before the next date, failing which they shall appear before the Tribunal.

A copy of this order, along with the order dated 31.01.2019 be sent to Chief Secretary, State of Rajasthan, through E-mail, forthwith.
