REPORT FILED BY THE JOINT COMMITTEE IN THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION NO.333/2022 IN COMPLIANCE OF THE ORDER DATED 03/07/2023 OF THE HON'BLE NATIONAL GREEN TRIBUNAL PRINCIPAL BENCH

- The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal had registered the application based on a complaint received by post from the applicant. The prayer of the applicant was to take required measures to protect and maintain Pandavanpara. The applicant had alleged that companies were using huge explosive material near the Pandavanpara adversely affecting the same and destroying its supportive rocks and that in case the same is continued, Pandavanpara will collapse.
- 2 The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal Principal Bench, New Delhi had registered the petition as application no. 333/2022. On considering O.A. no. 333/2022 on 11.05.2022 the Hon'ble Principal Bench had issued the following directions:

"In view of the averments made in the application, we consider it appropriate to have a factual and action taken report from a Joint Committee comprising of Archaeological Survey of India, SEIAA, State PCB and Collector, Thiruvananthapuram. State PCB will be the Nodal agency for coordination and compliance."

3 In respectful compliance of the above directions, the Board had nominated Smt. Bincy B.S., the then Environmental Engineer, District Office, Thiruvananthapuram to the Joint Committee as per order no. KSPCB/360/2022-EE-1 Thiruvananthapuram dated 19/07/2022. The copy of the proceedings is produced herewith and marked as Annexure 1. Further the Board Chairman had sent a letter dated 19/07/2022 to the Director, Archaeological Survey of India, the Chairman, SEIAA and the District Collector, Thiruvananthapuram for nominating officers to the Committee. The copy of the communication of the Board Chairman is produced herewith and marked as Annexure 2. SEIAA as per letter no. 1195/A1/2022/SEIAA dated 04/06/2022 had nominated Dr. Bijukumar, Member, State Level Expert Appraisal Committee as the member of the Joint Committee. The copy of the communication from SEIAA is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 3**. The District Collector, Thiruvanthapuram vide letter No. B7-443650/2022 dated 27/07/2022 had nominated the Deputy Collector (D.M), Thiruvananthapuram as the member of the Joint Committee. The copy of the proceeding of the District Collector is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 4.** The Director, Department of Archeology, Thiruvananthapuram vide letter no. ARCDA/890/2022-LI dated 29/7/2022 had confirmed nomination to the Joint Committee. The copy of the communication from the Department of Archeology is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 5.** Accordingly, the Joint Committee was constituted with the following members:

The Joint Committee members had conducted the joint inspection of the site on 23/08/2022 and the draft inspection report was forwarded by the nodal officer to the other members of the committee through email on 05/09/2022. The copy of the email communication dated 05/09/2022 is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 6.** However, the inspection report could not be finalized as Smt. Bincy B.S., Environmental Engineer, Kerala State Pollution Control Board and Sri. Vineeth T.K., Deputy Collector, Disaster Management, Thiruvanathapuram got transferred. On transfer Smt. Bincy B.S., Environmental Engineer was relieved on 05/09/2022 by Smt. Simi P., Environmental Engineer. The new Environmental Engineer had contacted the other committee members for finalizing the report. Accordingly, the member from Directorate of Archaeology had submitted the remarks on the site inspection report on 24/09/2022. Meanwhile, the Board nominated Smt. Simi P., Environmental Engineer, Kerala State Pollution Control Board, District Office, Thiruvananthapuram as the member of the Joint Committee on 27/10/2022 instead of Smt. Bincy B.S., Environmental Engineer. The copy of the communication is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 7**. The nodal officer had requested for report from the committee members and had communicated the matter to the Chief Environmental Engineer, Regional Office, Thiruvananthapuram as per letters no. PCB/TVM-DO/NGT-LEGAL/2022 dated 30/12/2022 and 19/01/2023. The copies of the communications are produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 8**. The member from SEIAA had submitted remarks on 26/01/2023. The inspection report signed by the nominee of the District Collector was received in July 2023. The report of the joint inspection signed by all the inspecting officers is produced herewith and marked as **Annexure 9**.

Report of the site inspection by the Joint Committee:

The Joint Committee that had inspected the site had reported as follows:

"The Joint Committee had visited the site on 23/08/2022. The 'Pandavanpara', a hillock of great historic and mythological significance is located in Neyyattinkara of the district of Thiruvananthapuram. The hillock consists of tall granite boulders and the same is currently intact. The Department of Archaeology had taken initiatives to protect the 3.15 acres of land surrounding the place including the Pandavanpara. A few rocks that were mined in the past were found at the site. The field inspection team could not find any

evidence of environmental damages currently in the area. Moreover, the area is now monitored by the police and the entry of the public to the site is also restricted. No mining and blasting activities were found in the region. The nearest active quarry i.e. quarry of M/s. Delta M Sand Private Ltd was located at approximately 550 meters from the buffer zone of the site and an abandoned quarry was existing at around 110 meters beyond the buffer zone of the location. The Kerala State Pollution Control Board or SEIAA had not granted any clearance for mining projects in that location. The photos of the inspection are produced herewith and marked as **Annexure A.**"

- The Joint Committee meeting was convened on 07/07/2023. The Committee observed that measures need to be taken to ensure the protection of Pandavanpara as the same is of great historic and archaeological significance. The recent study in Kerala to monitor the effect of granite quarrying was carried out during the period from December 2022 to January 2023 by the Expert Committee constituted by the Hon'ble NGT in O.A. No. 304 of 2019. Considering the effects of the factors like vibrations, pollution etc. the Expert Committee had submitted its recommendations regarding the minimum distance to be maintained from quarries to neighbouring residences, structures etc. which are currently under the kind consideration of the Hon'ble NGT. Accordingly this Joint Committee most humbly submits that no mining activity may be permitted within such distance of Pandavanpara by individuals or companies as may be decided by the Hon'ble NGT.
- In this regard, it is most humbly submitted that necessary actions had been taken by the departments concerned to ensure protection of Pandavanpara and as per the site inspection report attached, there are no active mining projects currently in the location as alleged by the applicant in his petition.
- 7 The Board as the nodal agency had taken earnest efforts to comply with the Orders of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. However, the acute shortage of engineers in the Board and heavy work load had interfered with the same. In this regard it is most humbly submitted that there has been only one permanent engineer in the Thiruvananthapuram District Office of the Board, during the period, who is the Environmental Engineer and the Head of Office of the



District Office which is having jurisdiction over the entire district of Thiruvananthapuram. There are no sub-offices for the Board in the district. The Assistant Environmental Engineer post has been vacant for the past one year. As such the duties of the Assistant Environmental Engineer also have to be performed by the Environmental Engineer. All the four numbers of Assistant Engineer posts of this office were filled on one year contract or daily wage basis. As such there was lack of engineering staff having the necessary experience. The Environmental Engineer who is the only permanent engineer of the Board for the district is member of a large number of committees. The frequent meetings and inspections in addition to the disposal of clearance applications, preparation of reports related to the various Court cases and environment matters are also the responsibilities of the Environmental Engineer. Further, the non-availability of the other committee members due to their transfer and other official engagements had also caused the delay. As such the delay in submission of the Joint Committee report was not intentional. Hence, it is most humbly prayed that the delay may kindly be condoned.

This is for kind consideration of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal.

This has ref. to the above. The Hon'ble NGT had registered O.A. No 333/2022 in the petition filed by Sri. S. Unnikrishnan with a prayer for taking required measures to protect and maintain Pandavanpara in Neyyattinkara Taluk, Thiruvananthapuram District. The Hon'ble NGT as per Order cited (1) above had also constituted a four member Joint Committee to have a factual and action taken report in the matter. The committee members are District Collector Thiruvananthapuram, Archeological Survey of India, SEIAA and Kerala State Pollution Control Board. Vide ref cited (2) above the Deputy Collector (DM) Thiruvananthapuram was nominated as the representative of the District Collector. Joint inspection of the site by the committee was conducted on 23/08/2022. Based on the said inspection and findings, report of the Board was forwarded vide ref (3) above to all other committee members for adding their remarks specific to their departments. The remarks from that office are not yet received. In this regard, it is requested to take necessary actions to forward the remarks of the Revenue Department on the above matter urgently for filing the consolidated report before the Hon'ble NGT.

Report of the Joint Committee:

The Joint Committee had visited the site on 23/08/2022. The 'Pandavanpara', a hillock of great historic and mythological significance is located in Neyyattinkara Taluk of the district of Thiruvananthapuram. The hillock consists of tall granite boulders and the same is currently intact. The Department of Archaeology had taken initiatives to protect the 3.15 acres of land surrounding the place including the Pandavanpara. A few rocks that were mined in the past were found at the site. The field inspection team could not find any evidence of environmental damages currently in the area. Moreover, the area is now monitored by the police and the entry of the public to the site is also restricted. No mining and blasting activities were found in the region. The nearest active quarry i.e. quarry of M/s. Delta M Sand Private Ltd was located at approximately 550 meters from the buffer zone of the site and an abandoned quarry was existing at around 110 meters beyond the buffer zone of the location. The Kerala State Pollution Control Board or SEIAA had not granted any clearance for mining projects in that location. The photos of the inspection are produced herewith and marked as Annexure A






Pandavanpara: Image 1


