**ORDER**

1. This Original application has been filed under Sections 14, 15 and 18 of National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 complaining that Sidhharth Vihar Yojna is a scheme of Awas Vikas Parishad, Ghaziabad who had developed the same. The land has been developed through various builders and developers who have raised constructions and residential buildings. Some projects have been completed and allowed to be occupied but in violations of environmental laws in as much neither green belt has been developed nor Sewage Treatment Plant has been installed and thereby constructions raised are causing huge pollution. Some projects are still under construction.

2. In our view before proceedings further let a factual report be obtained by this Tribunal for which purpose we constitute a Joint Committee comprising State PCB and District Magistrate, Ghaziabad

within one month by e-mail at [judicial-ngt@gov.in](mailto:judicial-ngt@gov.in) preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF. The Report besides covering issues raised like sewage treatment plant, developing plantation and other, may also provide status of existing infrastructure in the area to carry treated sewage (sewerage) and solid waste collection and transportation systems for processing at identified sites.

List this matter for further consideration on 12.01.2023.
