UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

This application has been filed by the DDA seeking permission to utilize the underground parking space provided at the Squash and Badminton Stadium for parking of vehicles by the members and users of Siri Fort Sports Complex and Squash and Badminton stadium and permission to open a canteen and pro-shop inside the complex to meet the constant genuine demand of the players and trainees of Squash and Badminton Stadium.

A report had been called for from the Central Empowered Committee.

The report of CEC (No. 39/2018) dated 19.09.2018 has been perused. The CEC does not have any objection to the proposal given by the DDA. However, this is subject to the following conditions:

(i) the Squash and Badminton Stadium (SBS) will be linked to the Siri Fort Sports Complex (SFSC) through an underground tunnel to connect to the South West Exit/Entrance to the underground parking area without disturbing the existing infrastructure at the two complexes SFSC and SBS;

(ii) 5470 sq. mts. Of the paved area at ground level in front of the SBS structure will be converted into green area after removing the existing stone slabs/concrete blocks; and

(iii) the basement parking at Squash and Badminton Stadium for security reasons will not be used when important national / international tournaments are held at the complex.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of DDA says that the

conditions are acceptable and that the construction will be made in accordance with the proposed plan accepting the conditions recommended by the CEC. It is further stated that less than a dozen of trees will require to be transplanted.

The undertaking is given to this Court by learned counsel which will be binding upon the DDA to transplant the few trees that will be affected by the Project.

In view of the above observations and directions, the application and the report stand disposed of.

Compliance may be reported to the CEC.
