ORDER

1. By order dated 11.07.2019, we had expressed our disappointment in the Gujarat Pollution Control Board (GPCB) having failed to comply with the direction contained in paragraph 34 (a) and (b) of the judgement dated 01.04.2014. The case was adjourned granting 15 days to the Board as a last opportunity to comply with the directions. Report has been filed by the GPCB through e-mail on 25.07.2019 by which it has been stated that the Notification contemplated in the aforesaid directions has been

issued and that the delay in issuing had been caused by the intervening litigation in the High Court of Gujarat instituted by the VAPI Industries Association.

2. In view of the above, nothing further survives for consideration in the case, except to direct that the CETP shall strictly adhere to the inlet and outlet norms as prescribed under the rules which shall be monitored by the GPCB and maintain strict vigil over the CETP.
3. Original Application stands disposed off.
4. No order as to costs.
